This is a kind reminder of the necessity to do the following:

- 1- remove my name from the designation of "General Manager" on the Trade license because it's been enough time for you to do so, keeping my name as manager will put me in trouble in case of any cheques are returned unpaid from your company account or any complaints may arise on your company for any reason.
- 1- please visit the Landlord "DIFC" authority and replace the remaining rent cheques they are holding with my signature on.
- 2- Please visit the company banks Adib and Rakbank and do the necessary process of changing the authorized signatory to your name or any of your appointed employees and please provide them with all guarantees against the company loan and other related matters.

Please do that as soon as you can and fulfill the terms mentioned on the share transfer agreement .

Please note that there was a mistake in my previous email that monthly installment is 29,000 not 39,000.

Greetings

I am sending this email to let you know that by today the probationary period that was mentioned on our contract is over.

as per the share transfer contract dated by 20/Mar/2024 the validity of the contract terms and condition apply once the approval of the landlord (DIFC authority) comes out and it's been a month or more since the DIFC has approved the share transfer meaning that the company is completely under your management now furthermore under your responsibility, including all the terms mentioned on that contract.

I would like to remind you that during the probationary period I have been paying the loan installments of 39,000 dirham on monthly basis to RAKBANK as of respect to the agreement we have signed now that the shareholder transfer is done including the probationary period which means you are responsible of paying the remaining outstanding installments against that company loan.

I have paid all the outstanding balance to all the suppliers we had been dealing with, and I have provided your team with clearance proof, but I've heard that you guys are still ordering products on the same credit account, which is against our agreement.

I have been waiting for our second agreement whereas I invest about 300,000 dirham and remain at 10% shareholder on the same trade license yet expend the company business and add hair education services but unfortunately for more than two months I heard no final decision from your side or from your respected husband whereas a lot of my income is lost,, here I am speaking about more than 700,000 dirham of the financial loss in two months. I wish you had been honest before we signed the initial agreement and made it clear that this partnership is not something you wish to do however, it's too late now, I am setting up my own Academy anyway, but this email and the purpose of it is to remind you of your responsibilities mentioned on the initial contract. Please be aware that the next installment for the Business loan is by the first day of next month.

You are required to visit RAKBANK and provide them all the required document after the company ownership have been changed and a copy of the new trade license where as you are the manager and provide them with a replacement of the security check that I have given them earlier as well as you need to visit the landlord and provide them with replacement of the rent checks that I have submitted to them earlier, which includes my own signatures, which makes me responsible in case of any check bounces back or return. This is very important because the value of these checks exceeds 1 000,000 dirham and I would expect you to do the necessary as soon as possible.
